ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- ✓ Schools provided learning opportunities that exceeded the SOL's.
- ✓ Elementary teachers received PDA's and were trained in its use.
- ✓ A three year plan for the distribution and replacement of instructional technology equipment was developed.
- ✓ The Washington County Benchmark testing process was implemented.
- ✓ English/Language Arts scores for sub-groups of No Child Left Behind improved.
