SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

Watauga Elementary 2016-2017

A. Work to improve one of the four core areas as outlined in Objective 2 under Curriculum & Instruction in the Comprehensive Plan.

OBJECTIVE: Watauga Elementary School will improve student comprehension and student achievement in all content areas with a concentrated focus on vocabulary development, fluency, and critical thinking skills.

Strategies

- Incorporate research-based strategies to improve comprehension, fluency, phonics, vocabulary, and writing.
- Increase use of informational text with a significant emphasis on text features.
- Increase use of and analysis of poetry in language arts.

 Increase concept of word through word study with a specific emphasis on prefixes (includes instruction in Greek and Latin roots.)
- Incorporate daily summarizing modeled by the teacher in a whole group setting.
- Incorporate daily self-generated summaries from students in all content areas.
- Increase comprehension and assist students in becoming strategic readers through text structure (both fiction and non-fiction), interaction, and analysis.
- Explicitly teach fine motor skills, leading to correct letter formation in manuscript and cursive writing.
- Explicitly teach the writing process in grades PK-5 as developmentally appropriate, including the school-wide use of the 4-Square writing model.
- Provide differentiation of instruction for all students including enrichment and /or remediation.
- Provide intensive one-on-one and/or small group instruction for at-risk students.
- Increase use of graphic organizers across the curriculum, including Venn diagrams for comparing and contrasting, flow charts for sequence of events, and when/then charts for cause/effect relationships.
- Continually analyze data to determine areas of strengths and weaknesses.
- Share data with all teachers to strengthen the vertical alignment of the curriculum.
- Emphases on fluency, the speed of word recognition and text reading, with daily practice and frequent modeling by the teacher.
- Application of higher level thinking skills through questioning techniques that invite students to share their thinking as it relates to author's purpose and point of view, opportunities to compare and contrast, purposeful implementation of critical thinking skills, increased opportunities for predicting, inferring, questioning, clarifying, and summarizing.

OBJECTIVE: Watauga Elementary School will increase students' depth of knowledge and understanding through explicit instruction and critical thinking tasks.

Strategies

- Incorporate cross-curricular inquiry to foster deeper learning.
- Increase the utilization of STEM activities to increase learning through cross-curricular processes and projects.
- Explicitly model critical thinking skills.
- Incorporate Super Solvers in mathematics' classrooms to increase problem-solving skills.
- Increase student use of and access to technological curriculum tools.
- Increase the use of open-ended questions during classroom instruction.
- Increase problem-solving opportunities for students.
- Increase understanding of patterns and the ability to extend patterns.
- Incorporate frequent opportunities for students to collaborate on class projects and assignments.
- Increase the use of formative assessments.
- Provide students time to brainstorm individually prior to working in a group.
- Foster classroom discussions regarding the process students used to arrive at their answers and discuss the reasons the other answers are incorrect.
- Incorporate a Problem of the Day and/or Challenge Question into daily routine.
