

SCHOOL PROFILE
Meadowview Elementary

Meadowview Elementary School is conveniently located just off Interstate 81 at 14050 Glenbrook Avenue in Meadowview, Virginia. Students from the rural communities of Glade Spring, Meadowview, Emory and Hayter's Gap attend the school which continues to be fully accredited by the Commonwealth of Virginia. The school adopted the Mustang as their official mascot in the spring of 2007 and now Meadowview Elementary School is proudly recognized as the "Home of the Meadowview Mustangs."

The present building is an open-space facility that opened on January 6, 1975. The school sits on an 18 acre building site complete with a paved playground area and playground equipment for students' use during the school day. Students in grades Kindergarten through seven originally attended the school; however, the middle school concept was implemented in Washington County during the 1991-1992 school year. With this implementation, Meadowview Elementary School began serving students in Kindergarten through grade five while the sixth and seventh graders moved to Glade Spring Middle School. At this time, our school population increased from 460 students to over 600 students with the addition of students from Glade Spring and Hayter's Gap Elementary Schools. The four-year old preschool program was added to Meadowview Elementary School at the beginning of the 2000-2001 school year and currently continues with two pre-school classrooms serving a maximum of 18 students each. The present enrollment at Meadowview Elementary School is 629 and the average monthly attendance rate is approximately 93.9%.

The school's population consists of 321 males and 308 females. It is made up of 92% white (non-hispanic), 4% black (non-hispanic), 4% Hispanic and less than 1% other. Approximately 61.3% of the population participate in the free or reduced lunch program.

Meadowview Elementary School has a faculty of 47 full time and 2 part-time teachers. One hundred percent of the staff meets the criteria of Highly Qualified. The faculty consists of 4 males and 45 females.
