OBJECTIVE 1: Continuation of improvement in the content knowledge and SOL scores in the area of Math 7.

Strategies

- Use data to focus on student mastery and achievement.

Strategies

- Grades 6-8 will use the same pre-writing graphic organizer for consistency.
- Continue a writing portfolio for each student in grades sixth through eighth.
- Eighth grade teacher will use Criterion for student feedback on writing.
- Students will use /develop an understanding of the writing rubric for peer and self-assessment.
- Continue the teaching of grammar and parts-of-speech at all three grade levels.
- Every eighth grade student will have a Chromebook for writing and instruction.
- All writing instruction for students with disabilities will be conducted in fully inclusion classrooms and practiced in small groups.
- Provide remediation for students based on areas of specific needs.
- Disaggregation of 2016-2017 SOL test results and individual strands.
- Target at risk students at the beginning of the 2017-2018 school year.
- Provide professional development opportunities for staff.
