**OBJECTIVE 1**

Glade Spring Middle School will improve SOL scores in the areas of Math 7 and math for our special education population.

Strategies

- Provide professional development for teachers to enhance the use of collaborative strategies within an inclusion classroom
- Co-construct, with the Training and Technical Assistance Center (TTAC) at Virginia Tech, a professional development plan focused on co-teaching and differentiation
- Provide remediation plans for students to identify areas of need and offer academic support to improve instruction and student learning
- Collaborative teaching teams will meet to discuss progress and areas needing improvement
- Teachers will utilize collaborative teaching strategies for students with Individualized Education Plans
- Provide tutoring and remediation support

- Pretest and posttest scores
- Classroom observation
- Curriculum team meetings
- Interactive Achievement Assessments

**OBJECTIVE 2**

Glade Spring Middle School will improve SOL scores in the areas of reading and writing.

Strategies

- Implement a structured writing plan using writing portfolios, and information pertaining to writing provided by VDOE
- Implement strategies to increase the number of students obtaining a Varsity Reading Letter
- Provide sample writings for students to score according to the VDOE writing rubric
- Provide effective data allowing teachers to determine reading and writing instructional needs
- Use Interactive Achievement to create and administer effective testing strategies and provide valuable data
- Provide tutoring and remediation support both during and after school

- Writing Portfolios and documentation of entries in writing contest
- SOL scores in English and writing
- Pretest and posttest scores
- Classroom observation
- Curriculum team meetings
- Use of writing assessments to guide ongoing instruction

### OBJECTIVE 3

Glade Spring Middle School will provide ongoing, meaningful professional development to support teachers in preparing a learning environment that supports the success of all of our students.

### Strategies

- Provide teachers with professional development related to effective instructional and assessment strategies that will enhance the student's learning experience
- Plan monthly faculty meetings offering professional development related to inclusion, collaborative teaching, and formative assessment
- Plan bi-monthly English and math meetings to discuss the use of effective instructional and assessment strategies
